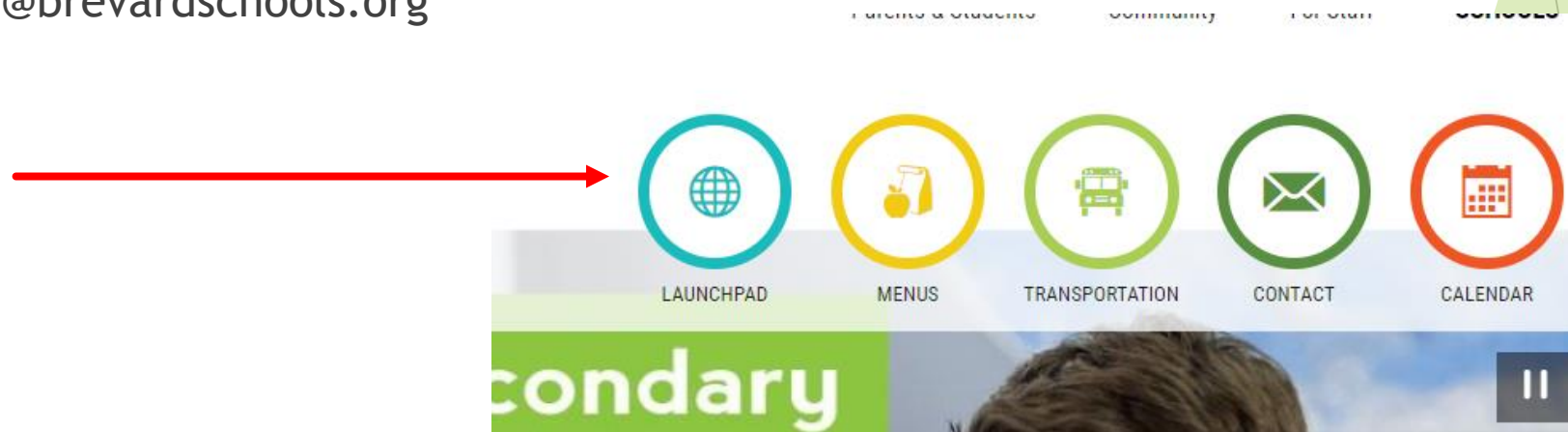



# Assignments and Grades:

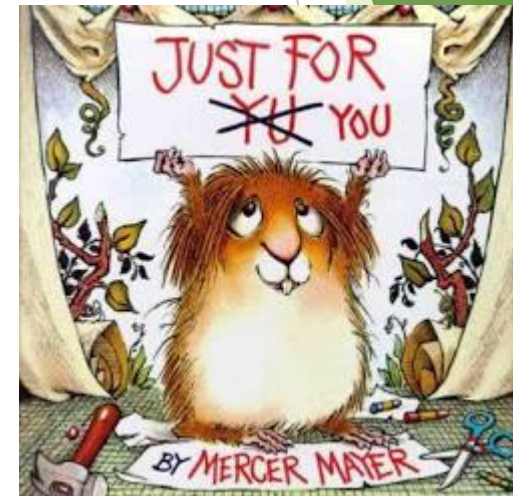
- ▶ Be sure to work your way through ALL of our class assignments.

# Things to Remember:

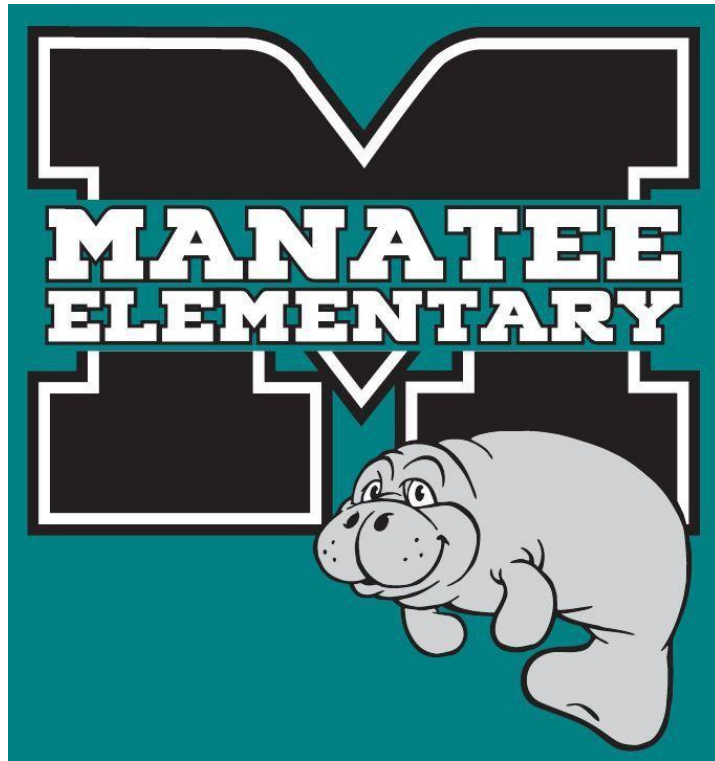
- ▶ I will be online daily from 9:30am - 12:30p.m.
